THE CHURCHHUB — WHAT IT CAN DO FOR YOU

As you can imagine, our shift from the old to a new church structure is a very complex process. Our friends at the General Council Office are working hard to make sure that everything is functioning properly and that any bugs in the ChurchHub are ironed out as quickly as possible. There has been frustration expressed by some Ministry Personnel and Communities of Faith regarding an inability to fully access ChurchHub, but we would ask that you please be patient and know that things are moving ahead as quickly as possible. I hope the following notes will help you get connected to the new ChurchHub network as quickly as possible.

Communities of Faith who have started a change in pastoral relations, but still need to post a PROFILE on ChurchHub.ca

Communities of Faith must complete their PROFILE and have it approved by the Regional Council before posting on ChurchHub. All pastoral Relations resources for Communities of Faith and Ministry Personnel may be found on the UCC Pastoral Relations webpage found here.

Communities of Faith who have not yet received an invitation to ChurchHub

If your Community of Faith has not yet been contacted with an invitation to ChurchHub, it is expected that invitations will be sent out starting Feb 1st, if not before. If your Community of Faith does not receive a request, it most likely went to outdated contact info. The accuracy of General Council files is only as good as what is supplied to the General Council by each Community of Faith. The first invitations to ChurchHub will be sent to Communities of Faith that are currently on the vacancy list (formally called the "Available Positions" list). Communities of Faith that are currently with ministry personnel in calls or appointments will be on the second round of invitations. If you do not receive an invitation, please contact ministry@united-church.ca.

Ministry Personnel who have not yet received a personal invitation to ChurchHub

If you have not yet received a personal invitation to ChurchHub, please be in contact <u>ministry@united-church.ca</u> and they will be able to assist you. The most likely issue is that the contact information that the General Council has for you is outdated. By mid-January, there were still 1600 ministry personnel who had not received an invitation because of outdated contact coordinates.
