Certificate in Ministry of Supervision

Queen's College Faculty of Theology and the United Church of Canada Office of the Vocation Minister (Atlantic) are pleased to announce a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) to collaborate in the development and delivery of the **Certificate in the Ministry of Supervision (UC) Program**. The program will be offered in the Fall 2019 Semester.

The Certificate in Ministry of Supervision provides participants with the information and skills to mentor individuals preparing for ministries by modelling pastoral practices, demonstrating congregational leadership and offering spiritual guidance.

Purpose: To equip interested clergy and lay individuals with the competencies and confidence to engage as supervisors with candidates for ministry and pastoral trainees.

Program Features

Available on-line (webinar) in real time.

Can be completed as non-credit or as a credit course toward a bachelor or master degree.

Has a practicum session to be arranged at sites reasonably accessible to participants.

Open to students from any region of Canada or beyond and from any denominational background.

Offered in 10 scheduled 2.5 hour sessions: 1:30p.m. NT; 1:00 p.m. AT, 12:00 p.m. ET, 11:00 a.m. CT, 10:00 a.m. MT; 9:00 a.m. PT. Sessions will be on Thursdays. First Class is September 19, 2019.

Non-credit Course Requirements

Attendance and participation, as well as some assigned reading.

Tuition is \$187.50 (50% of a credit course).

The course qualifies as continuing education and can usually be paid for from Continuing Education Funds.

Credit Course Requirements

3485 - Q Ministry of Supervision

Attendance and participation in sessions.

Readings and reflection papers on assigned topics.

Synopsis of Assigned Reading from the text.

Research on an assigned topic or a topic of the student's interest.

Tuition is \$375.00.

The course qualifies as continuing education and can usually be paid for from Continuing Education Funds.
