How best to avoid "Zoombombing":

Set your screen sharing option to 'Host Only'

1. When in your Zoom meeting, click on the arrow beside your Share Screen button \rightarrow Advanced Sharing Options...



- 2. In the window that open up make the following selections: How many participants can share at one time?
 - One participant can share at a time





How to turn off / restrict the Chat feature in a Zoom meeting:

 Click on the Chat button on your control bar → click on the three dots button at the bottom of the chat window → now you can block all chat or restrict who can use this chat feature



How do I remove a participant from a Zoom meeting?

1. Click Manage Participants in the host controls to display the participants list:



2. Hover over a participant and click **More** for these options:



3. You will also have access to enable or disable these options at the bottom of the participants list:

- Mute All / Unmute All: Mute or unmute all participants currently in the meeting.
- Mute participants on entry: Automatically mute participants as they join the meeting.
- Allow participants to unmute themselves: Participants can unmute themselves if they want to speak to others in the meeting.
- Allow participants to rename themselves: Participants can change their screen name displayed to other participants.
- Play enter/exit Chime: Play a sound when participants join and leave the meeting
- Lock meeting: Don't allow other participants to join the meeting in progress.
