GS 81 Extension of Temporary Amendment of Bylaws

re: Pastoral Relations; Temporary Amendment re: Congregational Annual Meeting

That the Sub-Executive of the General Council:

a) extend the temporary amendments to pastoral relations policies that were originally adopted in April, 2020;b) temporarily suspend the requirement in section B.5.1 of The Manual for congregations or pastoral charges to hold an

annual meeting; and

c) temporarily amend the responsibility of the congregation or pastoral charge to make a decision on their annual draft budget by allowing the governing body of the congregation or pastoral charge to fulfil this responsibility where necessary, and permitted by the regional council. With each of the foregoing to be <u>in effect until June 30, 2021</u>, subject to earlier cancellation or further extension by decision of the Executive or Sub-Executive of the General Council.

Issuing a T4A

A reminder to church treasurers that, if, in 2020 they have paid \$500 or more to any individual for services rendered (custodians, LLWLs, musicians, etc.), that CRA requires that a T4A be issued. The usual T4 slips are issued to those regarded as regular church employees. <u>Here</u> is what CRA says about issuing a T4A.
