VETERANS' HOUSE SPECIAL SERVICE AT BARRHAVEN

EOORC is aiming to raise \$150,000 in support of the United We Stand Multifaith Housing Initiative's Veterans' House. As you may remember, a **special service** was prepared for all EOORC United Churches to use to raise awareness of Veterans' House.

On Sunday, January 24, 2021 Barrhaven United Church gathered virtually for our special **United We Stand Sunday Service**. The service was amazing! It provided a very powerful message that helped us learn more about veterans' issues, especially the need for affordable supportive housing. The worship service came together easily using the series of videos created collaboratively by EOORC and Multifaith Housing Initiative (MHI). We linked most of the "United We Stand" videos found on the **MHI website** together with recordings of some Barrhaven United based segments to make the service our own.

We chose January 24th as the date of our worship service purposefully so that we could celebrate the February 1st opening of Veterans' House! But that wasn't the start of our journey – we began learning about veterans' issues and Veterans' House itself in November. Centering on Remembrance Week and National Housing Day, we raised up veterans' homelessness by incorporating some of MHI's videos found on YouTube into our worship services and providing information in our congregational newsletter.

Our special "United We Stand" worship service also acted as a kickoff to our capital fundraising campaign to support Veterans House. It is hoped that our congregation will be called to join with others in the Region to make a difference in the lives of veterans by contributing to this campaign.
