


### LIGHT A CANDLE ON APRIL 8TH

### REQUEST FOR ASSISTANCE FROM MUNSTER UNITED CHURCH

The City of Ottawa has contacted our Church (Munster United) regarding the possible need for a backflow valve on the municipal water supply line. There is a risk assessment to be done by a Professional Engineer or a plumber with certain qualifications. (Backflow@ottawa.ca)

In order to respond to this, I would need access to a CSA Standard to review criteria, but it costs \$184 and is not available at the library. Have other Churches been contacted about this? Most of those that I have spoken to were not aware of the program.

### **REV DR KEN MICKLETHWAITE**

We are sad to announce the death of Rev. Dr. Ken Micklethwaite at the age of 102 in Ottawa on March 15, 2021. Ken was ordained into the Methodist Church of England in 1949, and ministered to St. Anne's in Bristol and the Manchester Central Mission, before emigrating to Canada to become a United Church minister. He served the congregations of Crossfield and Madden in Alberta, St. Paul's in Brandon, Manitoba., MacKay in Ottawa (Minister Emeritus) and Olivet in Hamilton, Ontario. His favourite hymn, "Great is Thy Faithfulness" was sung at his funeral. In June 2019, Rev. Micklethwaite was featured in the Ottawa Citizen, when at age 100 he participated in D-Day commemoration.
