ATTENTION MINISTRY PERSONNEL: ANNUAL DECLARATION LAST CALL FOR 2021

All ministry personnel (including retirees) who wish to actively perform any functions of ministry need to have their 2021 annual declaration completed by June 30th.

To fill out the annual declaration, log in to https://churchhub.ca/ and "My Ministry Page." Look to the right for the "My Professional Requirements" box and then select the "View" link next to "Annual Declaration 2021" which will open the form.

- Enter the date of your last police records check and click on "OK" below the date box.
- Check off either the "I have" or "I have not had" criminal charges/convictions option that pertains to you.
- If you select "I have", you will need to enter in the box below that option details of those charges/convictions.
- Check the box "By submitting ...".
- Click on the big blue "SUBMIT" button.


