September 7, 2021 ONLINE GRANT-WRITING WORKSHOPS

Grant funds (\$500-\$5000) are available to support EOORC communities of faith in exploring your response to God's call in two ways:

- to engage in new ministry and mission projects to enhance your presence in the community;
- to discern your future in light of current realities.

The next application deadline for these grants is **October 31, 2021**

Two two-session online workshops are being offered to help communities of faith interested in preparing a grant application. You don't have to have your grant idea all figured out – the process of working through the application is intended to help clarify your ideas for the grant and your vision for the church.

In both workshops, the first session will walk through the questions on the application form using a case study. During the next two weeks, you will have time to prepare a draft application for your community of faith. The second session is an opportunity for group feedback to help improve your draft application.
