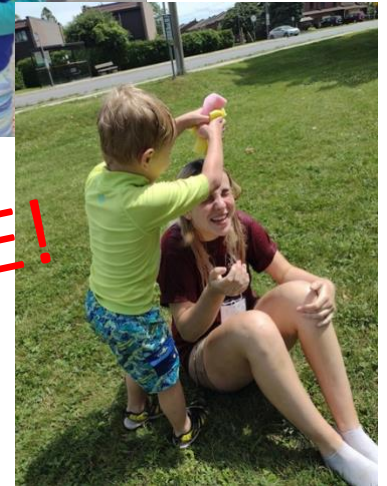


Camp Awesome Update

Rev. Angela Bailey - A Woman of Inspiration

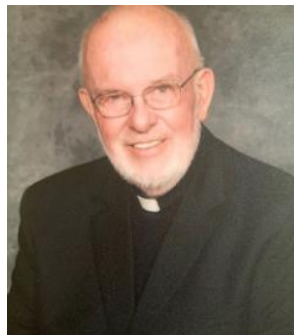
Rev. Angela Bailey was recognized as a **Woman of Inspiration** as part of the 2022 Celebration of Ottawa's Distinguished Women.
