

# Worshiplude 2023

*Worshiplude is a winter worship and fellowship event for youth and young adults (ages 10+) hosted by the Eastern Ontario Outaouais Region (EOR) of the United Church of Canada that coincides with Winterlude in Ottawa. It's been happening for over 20 years! Worship + Winterlude = Worshiplude. Groups plan and lead their own activities during the day and gather Saturday night for a collective worship and dinner.*

**Who:**

Worshiplude is for youth and young adults ages 10 + and their leaders.

**Cost:**

\$10 per participant. Cash or cheque (payable to EOR – Worshiplude 2023). Payment is required upon arrival at Rideau Park United Church.

## **Can you Host an Alt Space?**
