

Sacraments Elders Training

Communities of Faith who are expecting to be without a called or appointed minister for an extended period of time are invited to consider having a suitable person from within your congregation be trained and licenced as a Sacraments Elder. EOORC is offering a six-session training course (on Zoom) for Sacraments Elders beginning in September. If your pastoral charge has a suitable person to put forward as a potential Sacraments Elder, please be in touch with Rev. Whit Strong as soon as possible.



Mohawk Bible


The complete Mohawk translation of the Bible will be available this fall. It offers a deep resonance as a tangible symbol of reconciliation for all of our communities of faith and missions who live and work on traditional Mohawk lands. Read more.

The retail price is \$45 per Bible (proceeds will be going to language retention programs in collaboration with The UC Foundation and our Indigenous Church).

A dedication of the Bible is set to take place on September 9, 2023, in Kanesatake, QC. The translation is expected to be available in hardcopy, digital copy, and audiobook formats.
