Setting Our Sights Update

The Setting Our Sights strategic planning group is in the midst of facilitating consultations within the region. About 25 people gathered in Cornwall on August 26th and on September 9th in Pembroke, 19 people participated. Two more in-person gatherings are scheduled: Sept 16th at Kitchissippi United in Ottawa and Sept 23rd in Perth. There are also two on-line consultations coming up: September 14th at 7 p.m. for members of Leadership Teams, and on September 19th at 7 p.m. for everyone. Registration information is available on the <u>EOORC website</u>.

There is also an <u>online survey</u> which covers the questions that are discussed at the consultations. If you have ideas, please find a way to be in touch with the SOS group.

In these consultations, the SOS group is seeking ideas and needs for what the Regional Council needs to focus on in the next few years. As a framework for discussion, the themes of the General Council Strategic Plan are being used: Growth, Justice, Climate, Leadership and Common Good (how can we work together). One theme that has emerged so far is that this is an opportunity for EOORC to define and shape its identity.

In early October the Setting Our Sights group will be meeting to discern what we have heard and to outline our report, which will then be written to be discussed at the November 4th EOORC meeting at Woodroffe United Church.


