Upon the consummation of union, these properties shall be vested by statute in the United Church of Canada, and shall be administered by such committees and corporate bodies of the United Church of Canada as may thereafter be determined. It is understood and agreed that insofar as it is practical, the two camp sites shall continue to serve the purposes for which they were established by the Canada Conference, The Evangelical United Brethren Church; and shall be administered in such fashion as to preserve the interest and relationship of former members of the Canada Conference, The Evangelical United Brethren Church to these Camp Sites.

Real estate vested at the time of union in a body in connection with The Canada Conference, The Evangelical United Brethren Church, is as follows:

Carrick Camp, R.R. , Mildmay, Ontario.

It is understood and agreed that, following consummation of union, Carrick Camp shall bear the same relationship to the United Church of Canada as it has had to The Canada Conference, The Evangelical United Brethren Church. The United Church of Canada covenants that it will maintain a cordial relationship with the Carrick Camp Meeting committee and will co-operate with said Carrick Camp Meeting Committee in the realization of the purposes and objectives of said Carrick Camp, this co-operation to be provided through the appropriate agency of the United Church of Canada.
