### Phishing Email Alert

During the Christmas holidays, at least one EOORC member received a suspicious email. It claimed to be a report from EOORC, and was from an unrecognized email address. It was claiming to be from a consulting firm. The EOORC member wisely contacted EOORC Communications before clicking on the link or interacting with the email. We were able to inform her that the email was in fact not legitimate, and was likely phishing (a malicious email.)

EOORC Communications are sent via our Communications Assistant, Natalie Matkovsky. If you receive an email purporting to be from EOORC, but which is from an unknown email address (or is otherwise suspicious), please contact Natalie at [nmatkovsky@united-church.ca](mailto:nmatkovsky@united-church.ca) to verify if the email is legitimate. Please also note that EOORC staff use email addresses ending in “@united-church.ca”. If you receive an email from a staff member or leadership team member which is from an unusual email address (or is otherwise suspicious), please always contact that person via another route (ex. phone call) to verify that it is legitimate.
